

Introductory Training for the Motivational Interviewing Treatment Integrity (MITI) 3.0 Coding System

This 3-day training will introduce participants to the Motivational Interviewing Treatment Integrity Coding System (MITI). Using lecture, audiotape and group practice, participants will learn to recognize and categorize common elements of therapist competence in Motivational Interviewing. Participants for this workshop should have experience in Motivational Interviewing and a desire to learn the MITI for supervisory or research purposes. This course will include large group exercises in the morning, and individual or small group coding practice in the afternoon of each workshop day. Participants will receive feedback of their coding to enhance speed and accuracy of learning, will practice generating clinician feedback based on coded interview segments and will be ready to use this coding system by the end of this workshop, *including new revisions to the Global Rating Scales*.

Participants for the workshop will be required to bring two (2) audio taped interviews or client sessions with them to the MITI training, to provide materials for coding exercises. Please bring the equipment needed to listen to them, as well.

Learning Objectives:

Upon completing this workshop, the participant will be able to:

1. Evaluate clinicians using verbal anchors for two critical dimensions of Motivational Interviewing: Spirit and Empathy.
2. Assign behavior codes for five clinician behaviors integral to Motivational Interviewing.
3. Code other clinicians' work to practice their MITI coding skills.
4. Code an example of their work for future use of the MITI.
5. Learn how to give feedback in supervision using the MITI.

Instructors:

Jacque Elder, Psy.D., CADC is an Assistant Professor in the Masters of Addictions Studies Program at Governors State University. She is also a member of the Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers (MINT), and has been trained in the MITI Coding system by Theresa Moyers, Ph.D., and Jennifer Knapp Manuel, M.S. two of the authors of the MITI coding system. She has been presenting and training mental health, substance abuse and healthcare workers in MI for over 7 years. She is also trained as a Couples/Family Therapist through The Family Institute of Northwestern University. She is a member of the MINT (Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers), and has presented and trained MI nationally and internationally.

Ken Schmidt, MHS, CADC is a clinician, teacher and trainer with experience working in Substance Abuse residential treatment programs. He has his Masters in Addictions Studies from Governors State University and is a Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor. He is a member of the Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers (MINT) and has been trained in the MITI Coding system by Jennifer Knapp Manuel, one of the authors of the MITI. He has also been received extensive MI training by Bill Miller and Terri Moyers.
